

FAQ'S ABOUT WEDDINGS AT ST. TIMOTHY'S

1. *How many people does St. Timothy's seat?*

The Church will comfortably seat 275 guests.

2. *Do I have to be a member of St. Timothy's to be married here?*

No, you may have your wedding here even if you are not a member. There are however, non-member prices. You are required by the Episcopal Church to experience pre-marital counseling

3. *Does St. Timothy's require pre-marital counseling?*

Yes, every couple must meet with a clergy for counseling before the wedding. Alternatively, the clergy may certify that the couple has undergone pre-marital counseling through another church program. The Rector will review the process to see if it meets the expectations of the Episcopal Church

4. *Do I have to use St. Timothy's Wedding Coordinator?*

Yes, although outside wedding coordinators are welcome, all procedures of the rehearsal and wedding are under the sole discretion and direction of the Rector, associate clergy and Saint Timothy's wedding coordinator. Our coordinator can help you understand the church's policies and procedures.

5. *How far in advance may I schedule my wedding?*

Weddings must be scheduled at least ninety (90) days in advance but they may be scheduled as early as a year in advance.

6. *Can I have my reception at the church too?*

Yes, the Parish Hall is available for rental.

7. *How much does it cost to be married at St. Timothy's?*

Members and non-members pay a different rate for the use of the sanctuary and related facilities. Please call the office for pricing details. Our musicians' fee is payable directly to our director of music which is \$250, payable directly to him. If you want a guest organist or musicians, you will with our music director about logistics. Pricing on guest musicians will be set by the guest musician themselves. If the family gives a clergy gift, it is paid directly to priest.

8. *Are there any other fees?*

A cleaning fee is payable directly to St. Timothy's for the cleaning of the church (if there is no reception in the parish hall.) If there is a reception in the parish hall as well, there is a larger total cleaning fee.

9. *Are weddings scheduled on holidays?*

We typically do not schedule weddings during Lent (this period varies year to year between February, March, and April). We never have weddings during Holy Week, nor on Thanksgiving Day. Also, we do not do wedding on Christmas Eve, Christmas Day or New Year's Day.
